

ONGOING TURKISH AIRSTRIKES ON NORTH AND EAST SYRIA TARGET ELECTRICITY, OIL, AND OTHER CIVILIAN INFRASTRUCTURE.

25.10.2024

KEY POINTS

- Turkey has attacked at least 50 locations across NES since the night of October 23, with 20 confirmed attacks on October 25.
- The airstrikes continued to target civilian infrastructure including an electricity station, 2 wheat warehouses, a farm, and oil sites.
- The casualties from Turkish attacks have risen to 14, and the injured to 22.
- Turkish shelling also continued, notably in Manbij, where 1 child was killed and 2 were injured in the village of Bania

LATEST

Turkish airstrikes have repeatedly targeted the city center of Kobane. Oil fields (Odeh) continued to be struck, as well as Sadcop industry site which had already been targeted in December 2023 and January this year. Internal Security Forces (Asayish) checkpoints across Amude, Derik, Kobane and Qamishlo continued to be targeted. A plastic bag factory in Derik and a car maintenance workshop in Rimelan were also hit.

Food infrastructure was also further targeted by Turkish airstrikes. During the night, a wheat warehouse in the village of Rovi, outside of Kobane, was hit by Turkish drones resulting in 1 death and 7 injured. Warehouse worker, Hussein Das, was killed in the airstrike. A similar location, the Agricultural Development company, was targeted in Qamishlo around 6:45am. The company reported that the attack spoiled 100 tons of flour, which supplied bakeries in and around Qamishlo. The site, which also supplies a variety of agricultural products and foods, had already been targeted the night before.

The death toll from airstrikes since October 23 has risen to 14 (1 in Kobane, 8 at Suwaydiyah power station, 4 in Tal Rifat, and 1 in Rovi), and the wounded to 22 (1 at Khalij health clinic in Qamishlo, 1 at Suwaydiyah, 10 in Tel Rifat, 7 in Rovi and 3 Asayish members).

Turkish artillery shelling continued, notably striking villages in Manbij and Tel Tamir. Overnight, Farah Al-Barho (11 years old) was killed, and Abdul Rahman Al-Barho (13 years old) and Samir Barho (8 years old) were injured, as a result of artillery shelling in the village of Bania in the countryside of Manbij.

Today, the armed wing of the Kurdistan Workers' Party (PKK) claimed responsibility for the attack on an aerospace facility in Ankara that took place on October 23rd - after which the most recent round of airstrikes began. The DAANES issued a statement which accuses Turkey of "exporting its internal crises" and denounces "international silence" surrounding the attacks on civilian infrastructure.

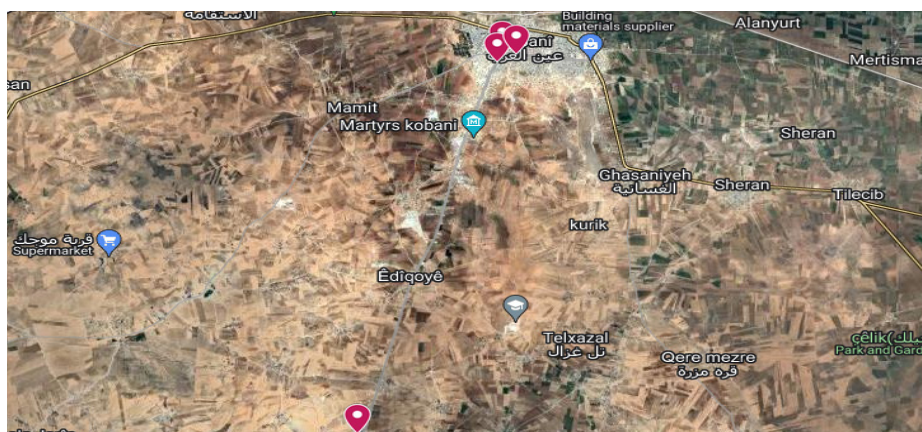
